

**Exporting Certificated (IE)**

1. Once the certificate is downloaded by default for Encryption certificate is save to browser.(Fig 1.0)
2. Open Internet Explorer (IE).
3. Click Tools
  - a. Internet option

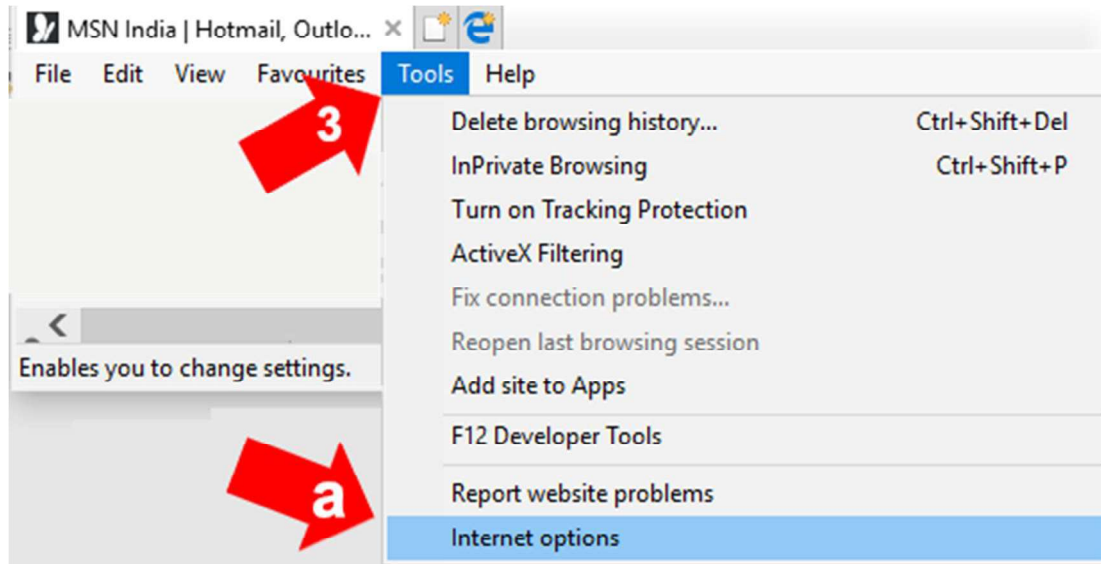

4. Click Content (Fig 1.1)
  - a. Certificates

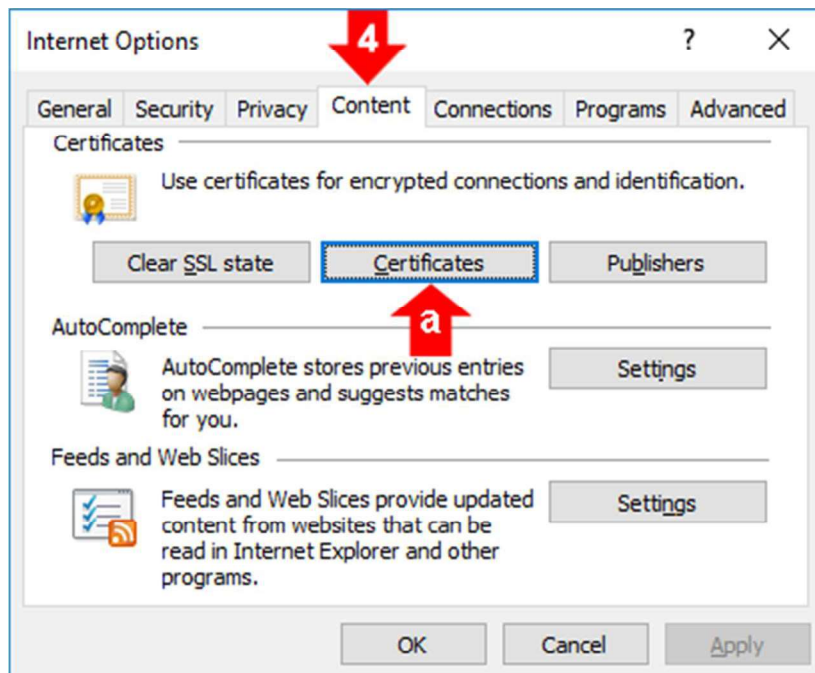

5. Select the certificate you want to Export and click Export. (Fig 1.2)

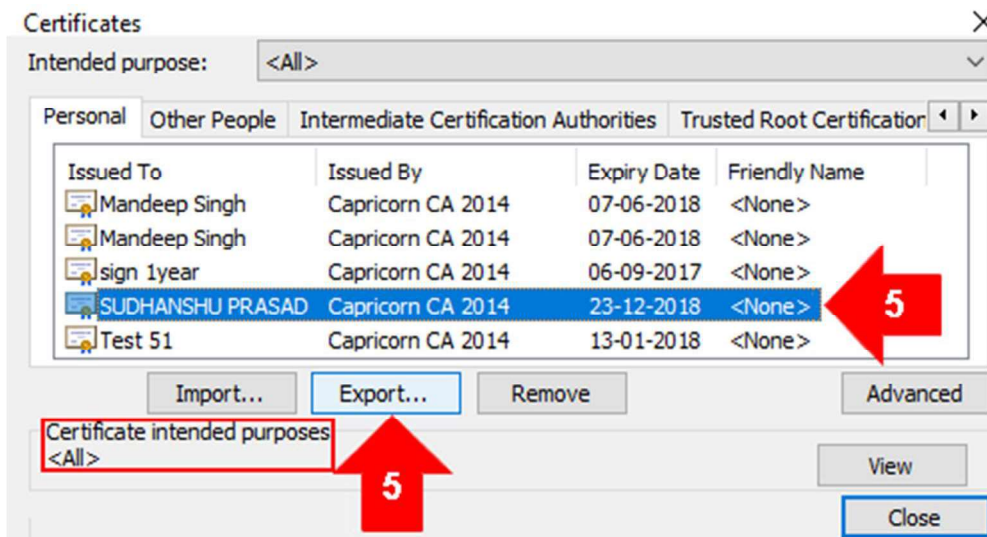

6. Wizard will open, click next to continue. (Fig 1.3)

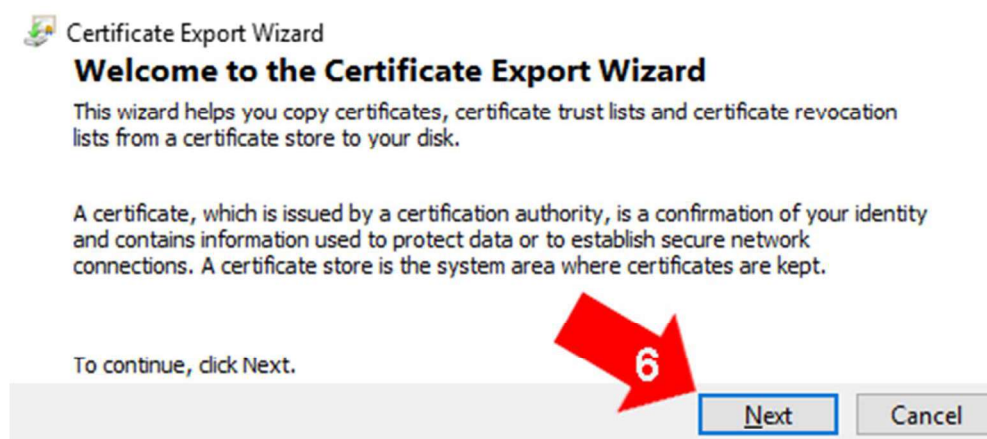

11. Click Next

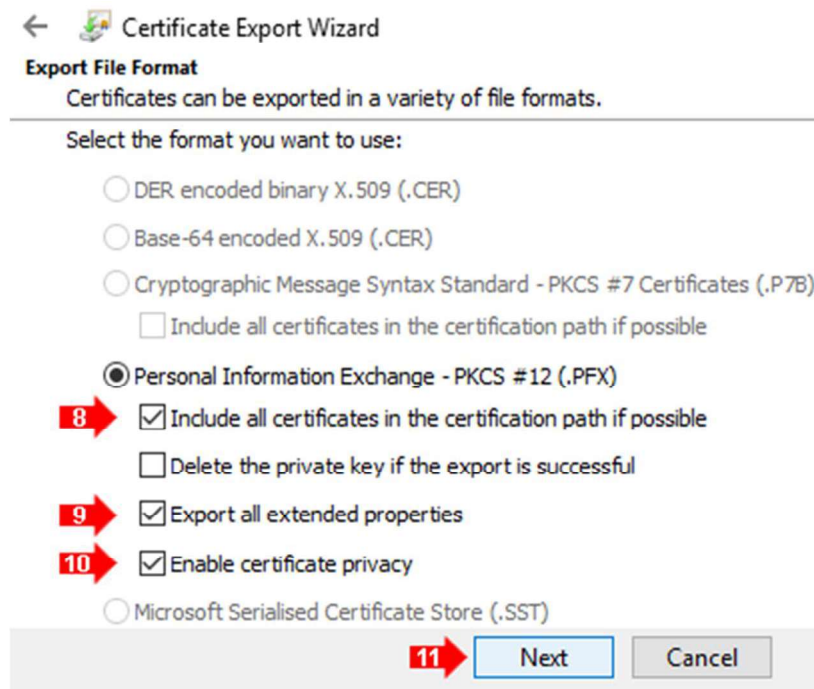

- 15. Click Next.

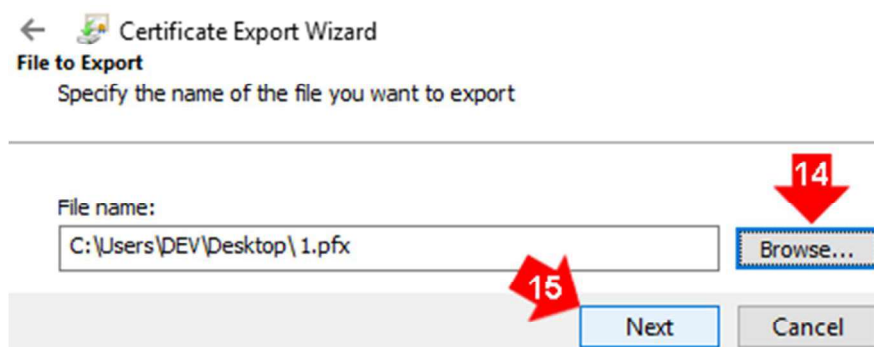

16. Click Finish. (Fig 1.8)

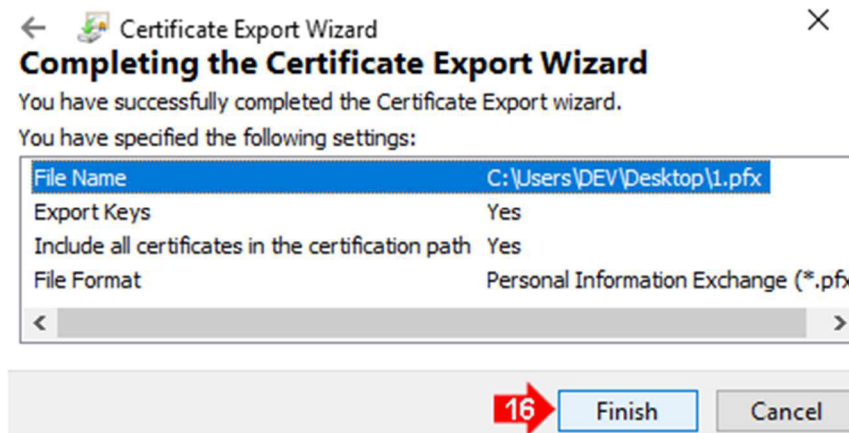

17. Click Ok once done. (Fig 1.9)

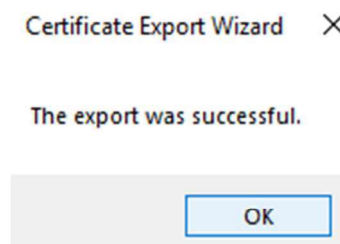
